Training Topic Descriptions:

Toxic Stress to Safe Zone Level 1: Understanding trauma informed care and responding to trauma's impact on behavior **ST10058070 (also 'Ohio Approved')**

The research on trauma shows the alarming impact it has on our young children in the United States. Early learning professionals are supporting these children in their classrooms at increasing rates. This training will give participants an understanding of trauma and toxic stress experienced by young children that they may serve. They will also learn the effects of trauma on social/emotional development as well as some strategies on how to respond to trauma's effect on behavior.

Creating Teamwork, and Motivating Staff **ST10058083**

Through lecture, discussion, role plays, and small group activities, participants will become familiar with the concept of teamwork, strategies to create a cohesive staff, strategies to work through conflict, and strategies employing incentives to bring out the best in staff.

Understanding Families with Substance Abuse: The impact of trauma on the brain **ST10058071 (also 'Ohio Approved')**

This training provides participants with an overview of the lifestyle of families who struggle with substance abuse. Participants will gain knowledge of the environment and lifestyle of families where substance abuse is present and begin to understand possible trauma experienced by young children in these environments.

Stewards of Children – Sexual abuse prevention training **ST10058084**

Stewards of Children is a prevention training program that teaches adults how to prevent, recognize and react responsibly to child sexual abuse. The program is designed for organizations that serve children and youth and for individuals concerned about the safety of children. It is the only nationally distributed, evidenced based program proven to increase knowledge, improve attitudes and change child-protective behaviors. This revolutionary program is for any responsible adult who cares about the welfare of children development, learning and relationships.

Power Struggles: how to avoid them and what to do when you are in them **ST10058085**

Participants will be able to distinguish between four goals of misbehavior and be able to identify when power struggles occur. Strategies to empower children to avoid power struggles and strategies and a script to detach and solve power struggles will be presented. Those serving children ages 2-18 will benefit from the content of this training.
